



Role Description - Sports Coach

The post is offered at a support staff level. (A teaching qualifications is not required)

Duties will include, but will not be limited to;

- Teaching the SJS Sports programme as described in the SJS Games Scope and Sequence document. Duties will usually be assigned through a collaborative teaching approach with the class teacher, however, there will be occasions when the Sports Coach will assume responsibility for the class, under supervision.
- Preparation and lay out of equipment for Sports Lessons.
- Responsible for maintenance of sporting equipment and organisation of sports storeroom.
- Teaching small group classes as part of the SJS Sports Enrichment Programme. The Enrichment classes for sport are held on Friday mornings.
- Coaching and advising on the skill development for School Teams as appropriate. At present school the sports covered are: Football, Tag Rugby, Basketball, Netball, Swimming, Cricket, Rounders, Biathlon and Athletics.
- Supervise and coach School Teams at tournaments. Tournaments may take place after school and on Saturdays as well as during the school day.
- Supervise classes as part of the SJS Swimming Programme. Swimming coaches and life guards will be in attendance.
- Liaison with the Lead Teacher for PE regarding the teaching programme.
- Liaison with class teachers regarding student progress.
- The Lead Teacher for PE will line manage the day to day responsibilities of the Sports Coach.

- Basic Coaching qualifications in one or more of the main primary school sports.
